GENERAL NOTES

Hampton Pier Yacht Club, Herne Bay, Kent, have kindly offered their facilities for the 1979 Streaker Championship.

The Club has changing rooms, showers, a bar, and there will be a running buffet open all day for light meals. Temporary membership will be extended to all competitors and visitors, and the Club will be open on Saturday for a social evening.

Car and boat parking facilities are available. A list of accommodation in the area is available on request and it is strongly recommended that this is booked as early as possible.

RACING

The series of races will be held under the rules of the I.Y.R.U. including R.Y.A. Prescriptions, the Class Association, and in accordance with the sailing instructions of Hampton Pier Yacht Club. There will be an optional practice race and the Championship will consist of three races with the best two results to count.

- (a) All competing boats must hold and produce a valid measurement certificate.
- (b) Helmsmen (or owners) must be members of the Streaker Association.
- (c) Helmsmen must wear a buoyancy aid at all times. Failure to do so will result in disqualification.
- (d) All boats must carry an anchor and warp and a paddle.
- (e) All competing boats must have insurance cover with a minimum of £100,000 third party indemnity. Evidence of this cover must be produced.

PRIZES

A prize will be awarded to the winner of each race. The Championship Trophy will be awarded to the overall winner of the series, and in addition prizes will be awarded on a scale based on the square root of the number of entries.

ENTRY

The entry fee for each boat will be £3.75 and entries should be sent in as soon as possible.
