

Buying guide

Streakers come in a choice of FRP, all wood or composite (an FRP hull with a wooden deck). Historically, some boats were made from GRP, but this material is no longer used.

New and used Streakers can be found with a variety of fit-out options, including a range of foils, spars and sails.

New boats are available from Class approved boat builders who can supply a complete ready-to-race package. Alternatively, a builder may offer to supply you with a bare hull, to be fitted out by yourself or an independent chandler.

Enthusiasts can build their own Streaker! This can be done from scratch using the official plans or you can buy an approved kit of parts.
