



Racing Series Rules

Revised June 2023

Super Series, Paddle series and other regional series rules

1 General

- 1.1 The events to be included in each series shall be those specified on the Streaker Class Owners Association events calendar as published on the Class website; www.streaker-class.org.uk.
- 1.2 To qualify for a series, the helm must be a current member of the Streaker Class Owners Association.
- 1.3 Series ties shall be resolved using RRS A8.1 and A8.2.

2 Super Series

- 2.1 The Super Series shall use results from the 6 championship events identified on the events calendar.
- 2.2 A helm shall score points equal to their weighted overall position at the event (see 2.4 below).
- 2.3 A helm shall count their 3 best event scores.
- 2.4 The event score shall be weighted based on a typical attendance of 20 boats and is calculated as follows:

$$\text{score} = \frac{\text{finishing position} \times 20}{\text{number of competitors at the event}}$$

3 Paddle series and other regional series

- 3.1 A helm shall count their finishing position in each race of the series, using the Low Points scoring system as per RRS Appendix A4, except as amended by these rules.
- 3.2 A minimum of 4 races is required to constitute a series.
- 3.3 If fewer than 12 races are sailed in a series, a helm shall count their 4 best race scores.
- 3.4 If 12 or more races are sailed, a helm shall count their best scores in 40% of the total number of races sailed in the series, rounded to the nearest whole number (see Table A below).
- 3.5 The number of races required for a helm to qualify for a series shall be equal to the number of races to count.
- 3.6 A minimum of 3 boats must start a race for the race to be included in a series (a 'qualifying race').
- 3.7 If more than 3 races are held at an event, only the first 3 qualifying races will count in the series.
- 3.8 For the purposes of series scores, irrespective of the race scores awarded at the event:

- 3.8.1 a boat that came to the starting area but did not start, did not finish or retired after finishing shall be scored points for the finishing place one more than the number of boats that came to the starting area;
- 3.8.2 a boat that came to the starting area but was disqualified shall be scored two more than the number of boats that came to the starting area;
- 3.8.3 a boat that entered the event but did not come to the starting area shall be scored 'DNR' (did not race) and scored points for the finishing place equal to two more than the number of boats entering that event.
- 3.9 The winner of a series will hold the series title for one year or until the conclusion of the same series the following year, whichever is earlier.
- 3.10 A helm may qualify for any number of series in the same calendar year, including both the Northern Paddle and the Southern Paddle series.
- 3.11 Prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the Association. Where possible, all Paddle series qualifiers will receive a prize.
- 3.12 A prize will be presented to the first qualifying helm in each Paddle series whose boat is 15 years old or more.
