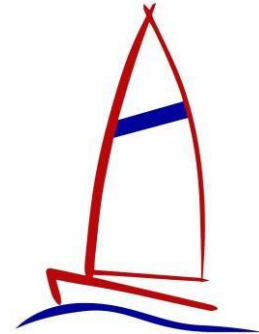

NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2021 – 2024* (RRS).
- 1.2 Competitors shall sail in accordance with the Royal Yachting Association (RYA) Racing Charter.
- 1.3 Royal Yachting Association (RYA) Exoneration Penalty and Arbitration will be available.
- 1.4 The Racing Rules will be changed as follows:
RRS 40 is changed so that Competitors will be required to always wear adequate personal buoyancy whilst afloat, except for a short period whilst changing clothing. Flag 'Y' will not be displayed; this changes RRS 40 and Race Signals 'Y'.
The sailing instructions may also change other racing rules.
- 1.5 The notation '[DP]' in a rule in this NOR means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

1.6 The rules of Staunton Harold Sailing Club will apply.

2 ADVERTISING

2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organising Authority. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies. [DP].

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1. The regatta is open to boats of the Streaker Class whose helm is a member of the Streaker Class Owners Association.

3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form, which may be downloaded from <https://www.streaker-class.org.uk>. Details of where to send entries and payment are on the entry form.

3.3 Competitors who are under 18 before and including the last date of the regatta must have a declaration form completed by their parent or guardian before they will be allowed to compete. The parental declaration form is part of the entry form.

3.5 There is a maximum entry limit of 50 boats.

4 FEES

4.1 For entries received before 25th September 2021, the fee will be £45.

4.2 For entries received on or after 25th September 2021, the fee will be £55.

4.3 If the event is cancelled, competitors will receive a full refund.

4.4 If it is not possible to sail the minimum number of races to constitute a series there will be a 50% refund.

- 5.2 The Championship will consist of five races.
- 5.3 The race committee reserve the right to modify the programme due to extreme weather conditions or other causes. This may include bringing scheduled races forward, except the first race on the first scheduled day of racing.
- 5.4 On the last scheduled day of racing, no warning signal will be made after 13:00.

6 MEASUREMENT

- 6.1 Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate in the name of the current owner at registration.
- 6.2 Each boat shall have its correct sail number on its sail. All sails must be from an 'Approved Sail Supplier' or have been individually measured. Any changes to the sail number must be requested in writing to the Race Committee.
- 6.3 All boats are liable to equipment checks on arrival or measured at any time during the Championship.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 7.1 The sailing instructions will be available on the event page on the Streaker Class website at least three days prior to the event and displayed on the official notice board. Printed copies will not be available at the event, so should be printed in advance if wanted.

8 VENUE

- 8.1 The Venue is Staunton Harold Sailing Club, Calke Road, Melbourne, Derbyshire, DE73 8DL.
- 8.2 Racing will take place at Staunton Harold Reservoir. The course will be displayed on the committee boat.

9 PENALTY SYSTEM

- 9.1 The Scoring Penalty RRS 44.3, will not apply.

10 SCORING

- 10.1 The Low Point System of Appendix A will apply.
- 10.2 However, DNF and RET will score the number of starters of that race plus one. This changes Appendix A
- 10.3 Two races shall be completed to constitute a series.
- 10.4 The total score for each boat will be the sum of her scores as follows:
 - 10.4.1 When fewer than five races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
 - 10.4.2 When five or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

11 CAMPING, AND BOAT AND TRAILER STORAGE

- 11.1 Camping at the club will be free for this event.
- 11.2 Tents shall be pitched, and boats and trailers shall be kept only in areas designated by the organising committee [DP].

12 RADIO COMMUNICATION

- 12.1 Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones [DP].

13 PRIZES

- 13.1 Allocation of Streaker National Championship perpetual trophies: -

'Tate & Lyle' Trophy - Overall Championship winner

'Under' Trophy - First helm under 20 years of age on 31st December 2021

'Over' Trophy - First helm over 45 years of age on 31st December 2020

'Well Over' Trophy - First helm over 55 years of age on 31st December 2020

'Past It' Trophy - First helm over 65 years of age on 31st December 2020

'Well Past It' Trophy - First helm over 70 years of age on 31st December 2020

'Still at It' Trophy - First helm over 75 years of age on 31st December 2020

'Scaling Belle' Cup - First lady

'Altogether' Shield - Club with the 3 best placed helms in the Championship

'Steve Gentry' Shield - Winner of the Silver Fleet

'Tune It Up' Trophy - Most improved overall position in the Championship from 2019

'National Open' Trophy - First helm in the Championship who qualified for either the

'Northern or Southern Paddle' series in 2019

'Fifteen Transom' Trophy - First boat at least 15 years old in the Championship

'Cadzow' Trophy - Best presented boat at the Championship

'Downs' Cup - Winner of Race 1

'Viking' Trophy - Winner of Race 2

'Ripon Horn' - Winner of Race 3

'Heron Salver' - Winner of Race 4

'Blackpool Bailer' - Winner of Race 5

14 RISK STATEMENT

- 14.1 Rule 3 of the Racing Rules of Sailing states: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone." 14.2 Sailing is by its nature an unpredictable sport and therefore inherently involves an element of risk. By taking part in the event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that:
 - a) They are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves, their crew and their boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the event.
 - b) They are responsible for the safety of themselves, their crew, their boat, and their property whether afloat or ashore.
 - c) They accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by their own actions or omissions.

- d) Their boat is in good order, equipped to sail in the event and they are fit to participate.
- e) The provision of a race management team, patrol boats and other officials and volunteers by the event organiser does not relieve them of their own responsibilities.
- f) The provision of patrol boat cover is limited to such assistance, particularly in extreme weather conditions, as can be practically provided in the circumstances.
- g) It is their responsibility to familiarise themselves with any risks specific to this venue or this event drawn to their attention in any rules and information produced for the venue or event and to attend any competitors briefing held for the event.

15 INSPECTION

- 15.1 The fact that race officials may conduct inspections of a boat does not reduce the responsibilities of each competitor set out in this Notice of Race.

16 INSURANCE

- 16.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £2,000,000 per incident or equivalent.

17 SOCIAL

- 17.1 All Competitors and their supporters are warmly invited to the Curry and Quiz on the Saturday Evening. Tickets cost £10 and will be available to buy at Registration.
